

Milligan Honored as Keynote Speaker at Department of Public Health at Mahasarakham University in Thailand

Gregg Tyler Milligan was featured at <u>Mahasarakham University's Department of Public Heath</u> September 10, from 10:00am – 12:00pm at an event with faculty and students to cover several global issues and ideas for improving the health and welfare of individuals who are abused.

Milligan used his own life example along with his experiences in working with social welfare and public healthfocused foundations and organizations, and wove those into the greater picture of the world at large including legal, economic and social ramifications.

Milligan outlined what happens when people who have suffered abuse aren't helped, and the rippling effect it has on society, and contrasted that with the positive outcomes when we utilize the model of Education + Compassion = Wisdom, a model Milligan has developed through firsthand experience supported by years of research.

Milligan also shared insights from his latest book, *Landscapes of the Heart - A Survivor's Guide*. Following the event, Milligan collaborated directly with faculty, staff and students at MSU to discuss the concepts illustrated in his speech and a practical application of the principles outlined.
